Meeting with Aaron Eberhardt of Westwood Development **June 6, 2009**

Plans for the nearly 17 K acreage are being researched firstly to protect both Hawksbill turtle nesting sites and the huge petroglyph fields, Pohue Bay in general. They are in consultation with naturalists, the Park service, U.H. and architects to document and define the boundaries.

They plan for a village, most of the commercial aspects of which would be mauka of Rt.11. To include: an airstrip or helipad, fire dept., hospital (possibly in conj. with the VA), security, housing, schools, plus a shoreline village including cultural center, hotel/ apts.etc. Also planned are new wells and a desalination plant.

They are working on a new Environmental Impact Statement and a new website is in the works which will include a timeline. Public meetings will be starting in June, and they are in touch with the CDP steering committee. Watch the current website, www.wdglc.com.
